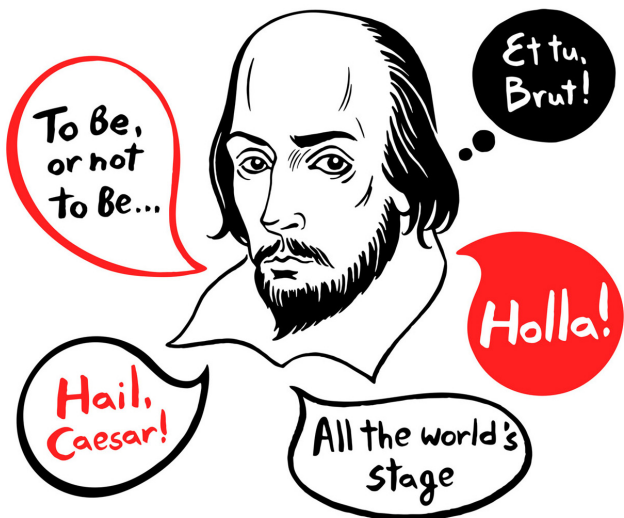

MISSION STATEMENT

Our aim is to create a unique opportunity for students to experience Shakespeare as his work should be experienced, on stage. The festival framework gives teachers the opportunity to develop their chosen Shakespeare in class through performance. With given texts and fixed timetables, the onus is placed firmly on the students shoulders to interact meaningfully with the project at hand. Entries are then invited to bring their own 30 MINUTE production to perform at the DLR MILL THEATRE in January 2019.

WORK WITH THE VENUE

In the initial period a Facilitator from the Venue will offer a Shakespeare workshop to your school to introduce your students to the concept and get the ball rolling. They will also provide you with a 30 minute script for your use. The competition is open to Junior Cycle, Transition Year and Leaving Cert Students.

DURING THE FESTIVAL

The venue's staff will welcome your group to the venue the day of the festival. Your group will be given a set 'Get-In' time to complete a technical/Dress rehearsal. Three schools will perform each evening of the festival to a live audience. On the final evening of the festival ALL AWARDS will be distributed.
